It is the policy of AMUD that any water that goes through the meter is the responsibility of the customer. Occasionally, even the most conscientious customer can experience a substantial increase due to a leak or break in their plumbing. However, our desire to be responsive needs to be tempered by responsibility to all AMUD customers.

AMUD will provide a ONE TIME water leak adjustment for catastrophic water loss due to customer waterline leaks.
AMUD will split the cost of the leak with the Customer using the following formula:
([leak usage] - [monthly average usage]) / $\mathbf{2 =}$ [gallons credited]
In order to process an adjustment, copies of your receipts showing that repairs have been made and the date repairs were completed will be required. Service Representative is to verify the follow information:

- The customer name matches the name on the bill
- The service address on the bill matches the customer's service address
- The date on the bill is within the last 30 days
- The invoice clearly states service rendered is a leak repair

In the event that the remaining balance owed by the customer still exceeds their ability to pay lump-sum, arrangements can be made to pay out the remaining balance over a period not to exceed 6 months.
